Academic Profile

Andrew Sanchez is a specialist on the anthropology of class, labour and corruption, and has conducted ethnographic fieldwork in urban India among industrial workers, trade unionists and entrepreneurs. He also writes about race and decolonization. He is the co-founder of the <u>Cambridge-Max Planck Exchange for</u> <u>Economic Life (CaMP)</u>, and was formerly the editor of <u>The Cambridge Journal of Anthropology</u>, the Economics editor of the <u>Cambridge Encyclopedia of Anthropology</u>, and a member of the <u>University Council</u>, the principal executive and policy-making body of the University of Cambridge.

Andrew's first book <u>'Criminal Capital: Violence, Corruption and Class in Industrial India'</u> was published by Routledge in 2016. Andrew is currently writing an ethnographic study of the Indian scrap metal industry, which addresses key conceptual debates in the anthropology of value and exchange. He is also preparing a major new collection about 'Mixed Race Thought'.

Andrew earned his doctorate in anthropology from the London School of Economics and Political Science in 2009. Prior to joining the University of Cambridge as Lecturer in Social Anthropology in 2016, he taught at the London School of Economics and Political Science from 2009 to 2012, was Research Fellow at the Max Planck Institute for Social Anthropology from 2012 to 2014, and Lecturer in Social Anthropology at the University of Kent from 2014 to 2016.
